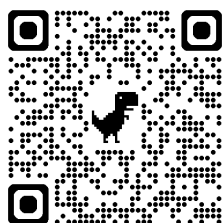

Classes will begin September 5, 2026

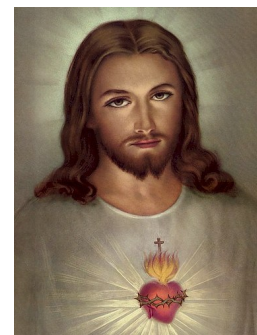

July 4 & 5

At the eastern edge of the Philippines lies Catanduanes, the Diocese of Virac — the first island to face the Pacific’s typhoons. Nearly 20 storms strike each year, with super typhoons periodically devastating communities. Though poor in resources, they are rich in faith. Serving 263,300 Catholics (95% of the population), the diocese has grown from 22 priests in 1980 to 72 today, with strong vocations and 30 seminarians. Your gifts will also fund vital Caritas programs: disaster preparedness, scholarships, clean water, microfinance for farmers and fishermen, feeding programs for children and mothers, and care for the elderly and disabled.
