MOMENTS WITH FR. ROLDAN

The Gospel of the Parable of the Sower reminds us that God is a lavish, extraordinarily generous grower. He tosses seed of His Word everywhere—even on paths, rocks, and thorns—hoping against hope that it will find a place to grow. God never counts a human heart as a lost cause.

The real question put before us is:

- What kind of soil am I today?
- Am I a hardened path, closed off by cynicism or routine?
- Am I rocky ground, enthusiastic on Sundays but quick to give up when life gets difficult?
- Am I choked thorns, letting the nonstop noise, anxiety, and digital distractions of modern life crowd out my prayer life?

Jesus calls us to cultivate rich soil. Deep, fruitful faith does not happen by accident. It requires us to slow down, clear out the weeds of daily anxiety, and deeply digest His Word. When we do, God's grace yields an abundant harvest that transforms both our lives and the world around us.
