Moments with Fr. Roldan

The Gospel this Sunday challenges our human desire for immediate justice. When we look at the world, we often wonder why God allows evil to persist. Like the servants in the parable of the weeds and the wheat, our instinct is to pull up the weeds right away.

Yet, Christ reveals a God of profound patience. He forbids the servants from acting rashly, protecting the good crop from accidental harm. This divine tolerance is not weakness; it is mercy. God gives us time. He knows that human hearts change, and today's weed can become tomorrow's wheat.

While we wait for the final harvest, the Kingdom of Heaven expands quietly around us, resembling a tiny seed or hidden yeast transforming dough from within. We do not have to carry this burden of growth alone. As Saint Paul reminds us, the Holy Spirit steps into our weakness, praying through us when we are exhausted. We are called to trust God's timing, leave judgment to Him and focus on growing deeply in His grace.
