Moments with Fr. Dan 22nd Sunday In Ordinary Time Year A

In the Gospel, we witness a dramatic shift in Peter's understanding of Discipleship. Just moments after declaring Jesus as the Messiah, Peter shrinks from the reality of the cross. When Jesus reveals that he must suffer and be killed, Peter objects. Jesus rebukes him sharply: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me."

This moment exposes our own human tendency to want a crown without a cross. Like Peter, we readily accept God's blessings but actively resist suffering, discomfort, or sacrifice. Jesus clears up this misunderstanding by setting the ultimate standard for true Discipleship: we must deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him.

Denying ourselves does not mean self-loathing. It means unseating our egos from the center of our lives and placing God there instead. The crosses we carry, whether physical illness, difficult relationships, or our daily grind of loving others selflessly, are not signs of God's absence. Instead, they are the very spaces where we are transformed. Jesus reminds us that trying to save our lives through worldly comfort leads to losing them, but losing our lives for His sake is the only way to truly find Him.
