The Independent Victim Compensation Program (ICP), a program sponsored by the Diocese of San Diego to assist victim-survivors who were abused as minors by priests of this diocese, is now accepting applications. The ICP is independent and not controlled by the Church. There is no time limit on when the abuse may have taken place. The program will consider all claims, regardless of how long ago the abuse occurred. No attorney is necessary and there are no fees of any kind. U.S. Residency is also not required. ## Moments with Fr. Dan

23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A

This Gospel offers a masterclass in building a healthy community through love, vulnerability, and accountability. Christ does not expect His followers to be flawless; instead, He provides practical roadmap for handling the inevitable hurts that arise when human lives intersect.

True love does not mean ignoring wrongdoing or keeping a polite, resentful silence. Jesus calls us to a courageous, private dialogue first. This step honors the dignity of the person who strayed, avoiding the destructive trap of gossip. The goal of this fraternal correction is never condemnation or proving ourselves right; the sole purpose is restoration to win over your brother.

When we seek reconciliation, we mimic God's relentless pursuit of us. This difficult work cannot be done in isolation. Christ promises His radical presence to those who gather to heal fractures, stating that where two or three agree in prayer, He is there. In a culture prone to quick cancellation and division, this text challenges us to build communities rooted in restorative justice. By committing to honest communication, we transform our parishes into living sanctuaries of Christ' peace.
