



## MINISTRY WEEKEND

Next weekend, May 17 & 18, we will have a Ministry weekend, at which time you will be able to join a ministry. God has given all of us talents and gifts. It's up to us to use those gifts. This weekend we highlight four ministries.

Minister of the Word (Lector) — The Minister of the Word or Lector is one who proclaims God's Word to the Assembly. They should be fully initiated practicing Catholics and in good standing with the church. Training is provided by the parish and the Diocese of San Diego.

Extraordinary Minister (EM) of the Holy Communion help the priest distribute Communion during the Mass. Those chosen to be Extraordinary ministers are to be mature persons fifteen years of age or older, confirmed, leading exemplary Christian life and recognized and respected by the faith community. Training is provided by the parish and the Diocese of San Diego. Extraordinary ministers also distribute communion to the sick and homebound parishioners.

**Sacristan** is charged with the care of the sacristy, the church, and their contents. They are responsible for the timely preparation, smooth implementation and sacristy to an orderly pre-liturgy condition. Also, the Sacristan lays out books, chalices and ciboria.

The Altar Server Ministry is a time honored tradition and privilege going back to the 2nd century! From the very beginning of the Celebration of Breaking of Bread, there were those who prepared for the Celebration, assisted at the table and put things back in order afterwards. Our Patron Saint is St. John Brachmans who was a Jesuit Seminarian in the early 1600's. Here at St. Columba we continue this tradition by assisting the Celebrant at the Table of the Celebration. Boys and Girls are invited to become Altar Servers. In 1994 women were affirmed to be able to serve with men by the Congregation of Divine Worship. The requirements are simple, be a Baptized Catholic, Receive Holy Communion and be in the 4th grade through 12th Grade. Our motto is "The St. Columba Altar Server Ministry develops growth and a solid bond with our Catholic Faith through our actions on the Altar and daily Life. Through Serving, We Love Christ."
