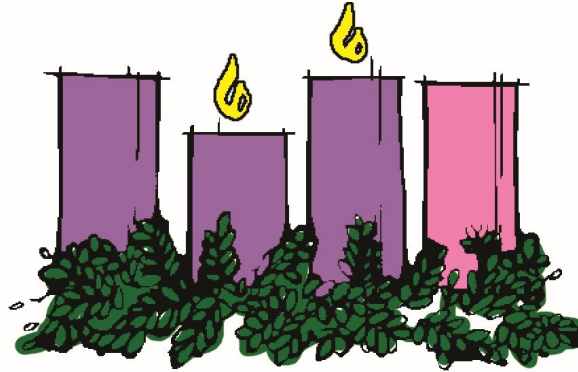

Holy Day of Obligation**

We joyfully celebrate the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed virgin Mary. This solemnity honors Mary, who was conceived without original sin, preparing her to be the Mother of our Savior.

As the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) reminds us, "From the first instant of her conception, she was totally preserved from the stain of original sin and she remained pure from all personal sin throughout her life" (CCC 493). Through Mary's "yes", God's plan for our salvation was set in motion.

Let us come together to attend Mass and reflect on Mary's purity and devotion, drawing inspiration from her faith. In doing so, we open our hearts to God's grace, seeking to emulate Mary's obedience and love.

Sunday Readings

1st Reading: Isaiah 11:1-10
Resp Psalm: Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 12-13, 17
2nd Reading: Romans 15:4-9
Gospel Reading: Matthew 3:1-12

In the first reading, we hear that a shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse and from this line a Savior will bring peace and salvation. In the Letter to the Romans, Paul writes that we are called to harmony with one another, and says that this salvation is open to the Gentiles. In the Gospel, John the Baptist calls people to repent and tells of one who is coming who will baptize with *the Holy Spirit and fire*.
