Sunday Readings

1st Reading: Isaiah 8:23-9:3
 Resp Psalm: Psalm 27:1, 4, 13-14
 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10-13
 Gospel Reading: Matthew 4:12-23

The prophet Isaiah declares that the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. God has restored their joy and smashed *the rod of their taskmaster*. Paul urges the Christian community at Corinth not to fall into factions but to be *united in the same mind and in the same purpose*. In the Gospel, Jesus calls his first disciples who respond to his invitation and follow him.

SEXUAL ABUSE COMPENSATION PROGRAM

The Independent Victim Compensation Program (ICP), a program sponsored by the Diocese of San Diego to assist victim-survivors who were abused as minors by priests of this diocese, is now accepting applications. The ICP is independent and not controlled by the Church. There is no time limit on when the abuse may have taken place. The program will consider all claims, regardless of how long ago the abuse occurred. No attorney is necessary and there are no fees of any kind. U.S. Residency is also not required. 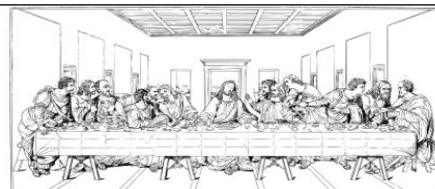
