Sunday Readings

1st Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6
 Resp Psalm: Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 10-11, 12-13
 2nd Reading: Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6
Gospel Reading: Matthew 2:1-12

In the first reading Isaiah speaks of the divine glory of Jerusalem. People will *come bearing gold and frankincense*. In the second reading, Paul writes that the Gentiles are *coheirs* and *copartners* in the Body of Christ. The Gospel from Matthew relates the visit of the Magi. They rejoice and offer gifts to the infant Jesus.
