

Sunday Readings

1st Reading:	Samuel 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a
Resp Psalm:	Psalm 23: 1-3a, 3b-4, 5-6
2nd Reading:	Ephesians 5:8-14
Gospel Reading:	John 9: 1-41

At the Lord's command, Samuel travels to Bethlehem where he anoints David, son of Jesse, as God's chosen king. Paul exhorts the Ephesians to *live as children of light* and to reject the works of darkness. In the Gospel, Jesus heals a man born blind. After the man is questioned by the Pharisees and eventually thrown out of their presence, Jesus finds him and invites him to believe in him, revealing himself to be the Son of Man.
