Your Blessed Palms

The palm branches received at Mass on Palm Sunday are **sacramentals**, sacred objects set apart for holy use. Here's how to care for them:

- **Keep them** in your home, placed near a crucifix or sacred image as a reminder of Christ's Paschal Victory.
- **Never throw them away.** Blessed objects deserve reverent treatment in accordance with the teaching (Code of Canon Law, Can. 1171)
- **When it's time to dispose of them,** return them to your parish before Ash Wednesday to be burned into ashes, or reverently burn or bury them at home.

Let the care shown toward these sacred objects reflect the reverence held for Christ Himself—The King whose entry into Jerusalem we joyfully celebrate.

Our opening Gospel reading presents Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. He is celebrated by crowds crying *Hosanna*. The reading from Isaiah portrays the suffering servant who trusts in God. In Philippians, Paul quotes an early Christian hymn that speaks of Jesus emptying himself and subsequently being greatly exalted. The Gospel from Matthew recounts the events of Christ's passion.
