This Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of the Divine Mercy - a feast day instituted by St. John Paul II to celebrate the overwhelming mercy of Jesus Christ.

Divine Mercy Sunday is a day of **extraordinary grace** - a unique promise given by Jesus to those who approach Him with trust, including complete remission of sins and temporal punishment for those who receive him worthily.

Jesus asked St. Faustina to be the messenger of God's mercy to a world wounded by war, division, and sin - telling her to remind everyone about God's great mercy, to always trust in His love, and to seek His forgiveness through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

SEXUAL ABUSE COMPENSATION PROGRAM

The Independent Victim Compensation Program (ICP), a program sponsored by the Diocese of San Diego to assist victim-survivors who were abused as minors by priests of this diocese, is now accepting applications. The ICP is independent and not controlled by the Church. There is no time limit on when the abuse may have taken place. The program will consider all claims, regardless of how long ago the abuse occurred. No attorney is necessary and there are no fees of any kind. U.S. Residency is also not required.
