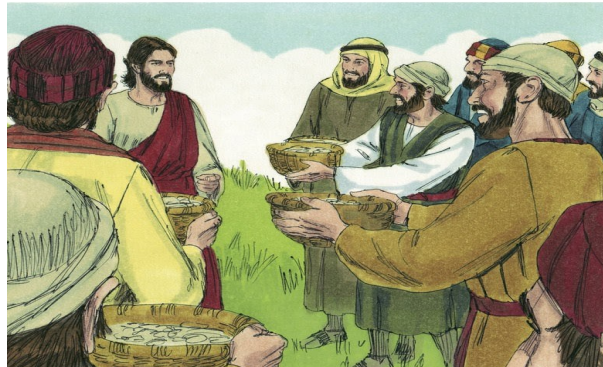

**Moments with Fr. Roldan**

Our readings today reveal a God of breathtaking abundance who refuses to let us faint on the journey.

In the Gospel, the disciples look at starving crowd of thousands, calculate their meager resources, five loaves and two fish and conclude that the situation is impossible. Their instinct is to dismiss the crowd. We often do the same when faced with overwhelming emotional, financial, or spiritual deficits; we focus on what we lack.

But Jesus flips this scarcity mindset completely. He commands, "give them some food yourselves," demanding that they bring their tiny offering forward. When we place our insignificance into the hands of Christ, he takes, blesses, breaks, and gives it back transformed. The result is a miraculous superabundance, leaving twelve baskets of leftovers.

This mirrors Isaiah's invitation to come to the waters and drink without cost. It proves that God's grace cannot be bought, it is a free gift born from pure divine compassion. As Saint Paul reminds us, nothing can separate us from this fierce love. We are called to stop staring at our empty pockets, trust the eucharistic feast, and offer our small "loaves and fish" to a world desperate for God's overflowing care.
