Moments with Fr. Dan

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A

The parable of the workers in the vineyard challenges
our human instinct for fairness. We live in a world
governed by merit, where more hours should equal
more pay. When the landowner pays the latecomers the
same full daily wage as those who labored all day in the
scorching heat, our immediate reaction is to cry foul
alongside the early workers.

However, this Gospel is not a lesson in economics; it is
a revelation of God's radical grace. God does not use
human spreadsheets. His mercy is not a scarce
commodity to be rationed based on senior priority or
personal achievement. Instead, the landowner's
question pierces our hearts: "Are you envious because I
am generous?"

We are invited to examine our own hidden spiritual
envy. Do we resent it when someone receives a late-life
conversion or sudden blessings? God reminds us
through Isaiah that His thoughts are not our thoughts.
We are called to rejoice that God gives us what we
need, not what we deserve. Whether we have served
Him for a lifetime or just an hour, the reward is the exact
same: the infinite gift of Himself.
