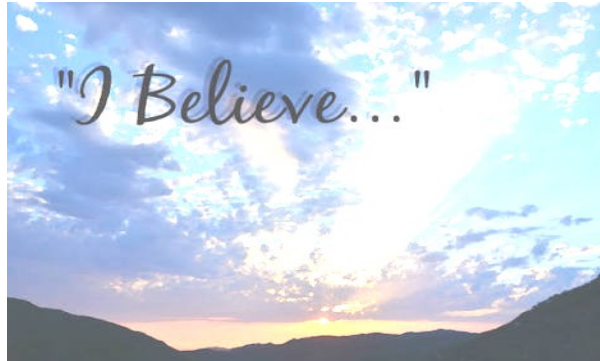

Moments with Fr. Dan

26th Sunday In Ordinary Time Year A

The Gospel challenges us to examine the gap between our words and our actions. Through the parable of the two sons, Jesus exposes a common human flaw: the tendency to offer lip service without true commitment.

The first son initially refuses his father but later repents and does the work. The second son says all the right things but fails to show up. Jesus makes it clear that God values the messy, honest path of conversion over the polished veneer of empty promises.

The liturgy reminds us that it is never too late to change direction. The tax collectors and prostitutes entered the Kingdom of God not because they were perfect, but because they allowed John the Baptist's message to change their hearts. Conversely, pride can blind us into thinking our religious routines shield us from the need to repent.

True faith requires daily, active obedience. It asks us to emulate the humility of Christ described in the second reading, emptying ourselves of pride to serve others. God is not looking for flawless tracking records; He is looking for hearts that are willing to turn back to Him.
